

Introduction to the Bible Month

What is 'Bible Month'?

Bible Month seeks to help people engage deeply with Scripture by focusing on a single biblical book, through reading, study, and reflection, over a calendar month.

By focusing on a single biblical book, participants may gain a greater sense of the importance of its literary and historical context. Readers may also gain a better understanding of the flow of a book and the links between different passages. They can explore different ways of reading Scripture, offering different angles on God's Word to us.

Bible Month 2020 focuses on the **Book of Ruth**, a short and sometimes overlooked story that shows God's faithfulness to a Moabite who travels to Israel. The Bible notes on Ruth offer a basic commentary on each chapter and the studies explore different ways to engage with Ruth.
